1	The annual calibration of the thermographs (for the walk in chillers) was overdue. However, I understand that you contacted the maintenance Company whilst I was on site and they were attending to this item the following day.	
2	On checking the thermograph records it was noted that one of the charts appeared to be indicating temperatures beyond satisfactory limits – I believe this was due to the ‘needle’ catching the graph. I would recommend that in any instances of the chart showing incorrect temperatures that a brief explanation is written on the

3	individual chart concerned. One of the milk floats in the depot did not have a 'no smoking' sign in the cab. This was addressed whilst I was on site. I would recommend that, on occasions, checks be carried out on all your vehicles to ensure such signage is present.
